Nation's first school district to serve 100% organic and non-gmo meals Sausalito Marin City School District and Turning Green set a new standard

Sausalito, CA – August 17 Sausalito Marin City School District will be the **first ever 100 percent organic and non-GMO (genetically modified organisms) school district in the country**. More than 500 students at Bayside MLK Jr. Academy (in Marin City with Conscious Kitchen Executive Chef Shaun Dayton) and Willow Creek Academy (in Sausalito with Head Chef Guillaume Pfahl) will eat sustainably sourced meals prepared on-site through a program called The Conscious Kitchen. The programs both get under way with the first day of school on August 27<sup>th</sup>.

Sausalito-based nonprofit <u>Turning Green</u> launched The Conscious Kitchen pilot program in August 2013 in partnership with Justin Everett, Executive Chef of Cavallo Point Lodge, the Sausalito Marin City School District, Whole Foods Market and Good Earth Natural Foods. The pilot served 156 students at Bayside MLK Jr. Academy in Marin City, a low-income community located five miles north of the Golden Gate Bridge. 

SCHOOLS READY TO GO 100 PERCENT ORGANIC: California's Sausalito Marin City School District will become the first in the country to provide meals that are 100 percent organic and non-GMO later this month, reports Judi Shils, the executive director and founder of Turning Green. She hopes others will soon follow suit.

Shils told MA her firm, which is managing the nutrition programs for Bayside Martin Luther King Jr. Academy, a public school, and Willow Creek Academy, a public charter school, is working directly with 10 farmers and six suppliers in the area to find necessary food items within a 150-mile radius. Cooking services will be provided by The Conscious Kitchen, another area firm. The schools will serve more than a combined 500 children, between kindergarten and eighth grade, accounting for more than 70,000 organic meals over the course of the year.

But Shils said she isn't worried. Marin County has one of the highest concentrations of organic farms in the country, she says. And the 156 children at the Bayside school have already been eating organic for two years as part of a pilot program managed by Turning Green. Thanks to donations, which helped cover the cost of chef salaries, the Bayside cafeteria got by on a budget of \$40,000 in its first year and \$37,000 in its second year, Shils said. The school replaced corn starch with tapioca flour. It steers clear of canola oil, using only organic olive and coconut oil. Read more here: http://bit.ly/1gVRsXv







Starting this year, Sausalito Marin City School District will be the first in the nation to serve 100 percent organic, non-GMO school lunches. The school district is partnering with The Conscious Kitchen—a non-profit dedicated to providing kids with healthier eats—to implement a food program built on the foundation of fresh, local, organic, seasonal, non-GMO (FLOSN) food, according to EcoWatch.

The school district is made up of Bayside Martin Luther King Jr. Academy, a public school with 156 kindergarten through eighth grade students, and Willow Creek Academy, a public charter school with 350 kindergarten through eighth grade students.
